## U7 Initiation Jamboree

### January 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Dear Coaches / Managers,

Our Iroquois Falls Timbit teams welcome your participation in our Annual 2-Day Jamboree

As we did in previous years we will have teams broken down to - Sr, Jr/Sr, Jr and Mini tyke teams depending on skill levels and will make our best effort to setup the games and schedule accordingly.

#### Guidelines:

- 1) This is an NOHA sanctioned Jamboree. All games will be played under NOHA Jamboree rules unless stated differently.
- 2) Teams must register with approved HCR team roster, travel permit and payment 30 minutes prior to their 1st game. Teams should be prepared to start 10 minutes before their scheduled games.
- 3) All games shall be 20 minutes in length with a buzzer every 2 minutes to change players
- 4) Teams shall play a maximum of 3 games per day; there shall be no playoff rounds
- 5) Schedules shall be created so that teams are only at the rink half a day (4 hours max)
- 6) Games should be played 3 on 3 plus a goalie (preferably rotating each game if dressed or each buzzer if not dressed)
- 7) Games and zones will be based on abilities to allow every player a strong chance to succeed
- 8) Faceoff to start the game only; No face-offs after goals are scored, the puck will be shot into a corner to resume play and if frozen by goalie the opposing team will back away to half ice.
- 9) There shall be no icings or offside.
- 10) No keeping score and no winners shall be declared.
- 11) Dressing rooms are listed on the attached daily schedule. Teams will be designated dressing rooms to use for the day and some organizations will share rooms. We ask that no players be left alone in the dressing rooms and ALL equipment is stored in closed bags when on the ice or between games. Girl's dressing room is available in room 7.
- 12) As per NOHA rules there are no Referees. Please have 2 coaching staff available per team, one on the bench and one on the ice (helmet required) to provide assistance to players - if no coach is available, please let us know and we will have qualified staff available if required
- 13) Please note on that games with highlighted times as we will have players names announced as they come on the ice. Players should organize to enter the ice from the benches in the same order as the schedule with a manager from each team announcing players at the timekeepers booth. Players should skate to the center of their ice surface then line up at their nets. (Coaches should help direct players on the ice as needed)

NOTE: IFMHA along with our tykes group have set up the Community Hall for everyone's use throughout the weekend. There will be toys, colouring and games for the children as well as seating for the adults. Please ensure players/ children are supervised at all times.
